Membership in the Natural Gas Association of Georgia is open to all public and private wholesale or retail natural gas service, distribution and transportation providers, marketers, and other persons who are interested in furthering the purposes and objectives of the Association and who are operating in the State of Georgia. The Mission of the Natural Gas Association of Georgia is to promote and advocate for the safe, direct use of natural gas.

Annual Dues: Small (<500 Meters) \$250

> Medium (500 – 2,000 Meters) \$750 Large (2,001 – 7,500 Meters) \$1,250 X-Large (7,501> Meters) \$2,500

• Project Costs: Voluntary

• Includes: Up to 2 named members

• RNG Steering Committee: \$2,500 (optional buy-in for >7501 Meters)

Membership Description

- **Active Member**: Open to all public and private wholesale or retail natural gas service, distribution and transportation providers, marketers, and others associated with the delivery of natural gas service. Active Members of the Association shall be entitled to vote on matters submitted to the Membership by the Association's Board of Directors. Each Active Member shall be entitled to one vote.
- * Associate Member: Open to all organizations that might not be eligible for Active Membership but are interested in furthering the purposes and functions of the Association. Only Active Members have voting rights, but all Associate Members shall be entitled to be heard at any meeting of the Association through their appointed representatives.
- **Vendor Member**: Open to business vendors of the natural gas industry. The Associate Vendor Members, via popular vote may fill one Board Seat. The At Large Board Member will be considered an Active Member and may vote on matters coming before the Board.
- ❖ Municipal Member: Open to all municipally owned natural gas distribution systems in Georgia. Once the number of Associate Municipal Members has grown to 20 in number and \$5,000 in aggregate annual dues, an "At Large" Board Seat will be established. The Associate Municipal Members, via popular vote may fill the Board Seat. The At Large Board Member will be considered an Active Member and may vote on matters coming before the Board.
- **Honorary Member:** In recognition of distinguished service and achievement, membership may be conferred upon a person or organization by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. No dues.
- * RNG Steering Committee Member: Open to individuals or companies interested in supporting Renewable Natural Gas development projects.
